

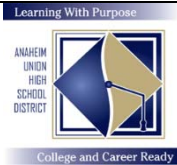

APPLICATION CRITERIA: *The applicant must meet the following criteria:*

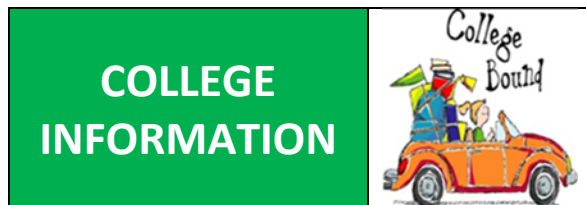
1. Must attend an AUHSD High School and/or private school in Anaheim
